

2007 CSA Contract

CSA Membership

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA Food Club) is for community members who invest in a local farm's production of fresh, local, chemical-free vegetables. As a World Hunger Relief CSA member you will receive your weekly share of produce at one of three locations throughout the growing season.

Our Commitment

For our CSA members we commit ourselves to:

- Providing fresh chemical-free vegetables throughout the 7-month season
- Educating members with nutrition facts and recipes for cooking vegetables
- Tithing 10% of our produce to Caritas (last year we donated approximately \$3000 worth!)
- Opening our farm for your visits and learning experiences

The volume and variety of produce will vary with season, weather, and pest problems, but should typically include a half bushel of:

Spring (April-May): lettuce, broccoli, kale, chard, spinach, peas, potatoes, and cabbage...

Summer (June-July): cucumbers, beans, squash, zucchini, tomatoes, peppers, okra, eggplant, melons, and corn...

August-September: two month break due to heat

Fall (October-December): peppers, eggplant, beans, winter squash, boc choy, kale, melons, mustard greens, collards, lettuce, spinach, and pumpkins...

Cost

Our annual membership fee is \$60 plus a monthly fee of \$50 for members who pick up their produce at the farm and \$60 for members who pick up their produce at the Piper Center (downtown Waco) or Central Presbyterian Church (Woodway). Once the season begins, you will be billed at the end of each month.

Your Commitment

By filling out this contract, you are committing to one year of membership including:

- Paying your monthly fee promptly
- Taking an interest in your farm by visiting, praying for us and/or volunteering
- Informing us in advance if you will not be able to pick up your share so that we can provide more food for our other members.

If you plan to be out of town for multiple weeks, we suggest you find someone else to pick up your share since your commitment is for the entire seven-month season.

How to join

Membership is available on a limited first-come, first-served basis. We have about 70 shares available and in order to participate in the 2007 season, we ask that you fill out the following application and send it in along with your \$60 subscription fee. Please keep a copy of this contract for your records.
